

WHAT IS A SCHOOL-BASED TRAINEESHIP?

A training program that offers First Nations students the option of undertaking paid, parttime work whilst completing Year 11 and 12. Students will receive valuable work experience with a host employer and will earn a Nationally recognised qualification, with credits going towards their VCE/VCAL, TCE and HSC qualification.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS TO FIRST NATIONS STUDENTS?



Work one day a week while completing year 11 and 12



Gain credit towards your VCE/ VCAL, TCE and HSC qualification



Earn a salary (national training wage)



Potential to explore career opportunities with your host



Gain essential work experience



Receive career support through an AFL SportsReady First Nations Mentor



Complete a Nationally recognised gualification

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO BE PART OF THE PROGRAM?

The program is open to all students who are:

- Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander peoples
- At least 15 years of age
- Commencing VCE, VCAL, TCE, or HSC in 2023

WHERE YOU CAN WORK AS A SCHOOL-BASED TRAINEE?

AFL SportsReady currently offers Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander school- based traineeships in banking and finance with ANZ and the Commonwealth Bank.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MUCH WILL I BE PAID AS A TRAINEE?	Trainees are paid at the National Training Wage Award.
WHAT QUALIFICATION WILL I BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE, AND DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR IT?	As part of your school-based traineeship you will complete a Certificate II in Workplace Skills. The qualification is fully funded.
WHAT SUPPORT WILL I RECEIVE AS A TRAINEE?	All trainees are assigned a Field Officer and Educator to support you throughout your traineeship. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander trainees also receive the support of a First Nations Mentor to provide personal, cultural & career pathway support.
HOW MANY HOURS DO I HAVE TO WORK?	You will work one day per week (7.6 hours) onsite with your host employer.
WHEN DO I START?	The school-based traineeship commences in December 2022.
