ALL LIBRARY BOOKS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE LIBRARY

If you have a library book(s), place the book in the return drop chute located at the front of each library desk. The return chutes can be used at any time! Any book that has been damaged, lost should be reported to the library staff before school from 8.30am to 8.50am.

If your child has lost their library book, please ask them to look at home or in their classroom library to see if the missing book is there. Lost books often turn up somewhere in a child's classroom! If you are still unable to find a lost book after searching both home and the classroom, please speak to library staff who will be available in the junior library located near reception from 8.30am to 8.50am and afterschool to discuss the options available.

Invoices for lost or misplaced books will be sent home the week of 10 December and may incur a \$15.00 fee per book.
