With a little help from his penguin friends, Plume is off to the North Pole. It's up to him to save Christmas. Can he help Santa ... and make children's Christmas wishes come true?

























She also has terrible news from the North Pole. Santa's elves are **Sick**, and toy-making has come to a halt! WHO WILL SAVE CHRISTMAS?

Plume gasps! **Santa Claus** has wishlists from children all over the world – their **hearts** will be broken.












