

2025 Term 2 Parent Overview



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Religion

This term, students are learning about the key events of Easter and the importance of Jesus' death and resurrection in the Christian faith. They will also explore one of Jesus' appearances to His disciples after the resurrection at the Sea of Galilee. Students will compare different Bible stories to understand key messages, and they'll learn about important figures in the Catholic Church.

Wellbeing

This term in Wellbeing, students have been revisiting our school expectations and exploring how to contribute to a positive and respectful community. They've continued learning about cyber safety through the *Inform and Empower* program. Through the Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships (RRRR) framework, students have focused on positive coping, turn taking, facing fears, problem solving, and teamwork through fun, collaborative games.

English

This term, students have been developing their reading and writing skills by learning to express opinions, make personal connections to texts, and understand how images and sounds influence meaning. They've expanded their vocabulary by exploring verbs, practiced writing procedures and responses using proper text structure, and explored Dreamtime stories to learn about Indigenous perspectives and storytelling.

Maths

This term in Mathematics, students are exploring key concepts through hands-on activities and real-life contexts. They are building their understanding of place value by working with tens and ones (and hundreds for some), helping them read, write, and compare numbers. In addition and subtraction, students are using strategies like number lines and counting on to solve problems with confidence. They are also learning about measurement using both informal tools (like blocks and hand spans) and formal units (such as centimetres and metres) to measure length. Finally, students will explore patterns, creating and identifying repeating and growing sequences using numbers, objects, and shapes.

Inquiry

This term, students will focus on - Media Arts. They will explore how to create and communicate ideas using a mix of sound, movement, text, and interactive elements using their iPads and a range of apps. Through hands-on experiences they will create their own media artworks to communicate their ideas and share their work with peers and teachers'.
