# Competitive Sport Uniform

## Parameters of Wear Guidelines

# Purpose of the Competitive Sportswear Range

The Competitive Sportswear Range has been developed to support students representing Overnewton in ACS Sport, the Year 5 and 6 Sport Program, and the College's Premier Sports teams in Athletics and Cross Country.

The range has been developed to provide students participating in competitive and representative sporting programs with apparel designed for performance, comfort and team identity. It reflects the pride and professionalism of Overnewton athletes while ensuring students are equipped with high quality garments appropriate for training, competition and official sporting commitments.

The Competitive Sportswear Range sits alongside the College Physical Education uniform and is not intended for everyday school wear. Instead, it is worn by students for competitive teams or selected sporting programs where a distinct performance uniform supports both team representation and the expectations of interschool competition.





## Guidelines

Students representing the College in competitive sport must wear the approved uniform for their sport, including the top, shorts or dress, and correct socks. Only approved undergarments or base layers may be worn (for example, a plain white underlayer).

Competition uniforms must be worn as a complete set and must not be mixed with items from other sports (e.g. football shorts with a soccer jersey).

Where a sport does not yet have a designated performance uniform, the College Physical Education top and shorts remain the approved playing uniform.

## Not Permitted

The following items are not permitted during matches or while representing the College:

- Generic or non-school sport shorts
- Mixing Physical Education uniform items with Competitive Sport uniform items
- Non-school outerwear or local club apparel (e.g. hoodies or socks)
- Visible branded compression garments unless approved and in school colours (white).



# Match Day Expectations

- Students must wear the approved Competitive Sport uniform for their specific sport.
- Competitive Sport tops and shorts must not be worn as general school or Physical Education attire.
- The Physical Education uniform remains the daily sports uniform worn to school on ACS Sport and Year 5 and 6 Sport days
- Students should change into their match uniform prior to their game.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **Why has Overnewton introduced a new Competitive Sportswear Range?**

The new Competitive Sportswear Range has been introduced to provide students representing Overnewton in sport with a high-quality performance uniform designed specifically for competition. The review also identified that many sports had developed their own unique uniform designs over time, resulting in a wide range of styles across teams. The new range creates a unified look across College sport so that students representing Overnewton can stand together with a premium, consistent and recognisable identity.

## **Why has the College moved to a user-pays model for the Competitive Sportswear Range?**

The Competitive Sportswear Range operates on a user-pays model, meaning that students representing the College in a particular sport purchase the uniform required for that team and/or squad.

This approach allows the College to provide sport-specific performance garments designed for the demands of each sport, while also offering a wider range of sizes and fits to better accommodate different student body shapes and comfort needs.

## **What is different about the new design?**

The revised design incorporates a bolder colour palette of navy, sky blue, white, and ruby red and prominently features the College's crest within the garment. The colours and crest reflect Overnewton's evolving brand identity while creating a strong and recognisable presence on the field.

The wave pattern woven through the design symbolises the connection of water between the Yirramboi Campus and Canowindra Campus, representing the shared identity of Overnewton across both campuses and the unity of students competing under one College banner.

## Quick Guide for Families

### **Who needs the new uniform now?**

Students who are representing the College in sports included in Phase 1 of the Competitive Sportswear Range rollout will require the new uniform.

### **When is it required from?**

Term 2, 2026.

### **What do students wear to school?**

Students wear their Physical Education uniform to school. When travelling to fixtures, students may remain in their Physical Education uniform or change into their Competitive Sportswear uniform prior to departure. The Competitive Sportswear uniform must be worn in full while competing, including when on the sidelines or not actively in play.

### **When must students wear the Competitive Sportswear uniform?**

All ACS Sport and Year 5 and 6 Sport sessions, including both games and training. As a performance uniform, it is designed to support students in both competition and training environments.

## When do students wear the uniform?

### **Will teams move to the new uniforms immediately?**

Yes. Students representing the College in sports that use the Competitive Sportswear Range will be required to purchase and wear the new uniform from the commencement of fixtures in Term 2, 2026. This change was communicated to families during the 2025 school year.

### **Will the Physical Education uniform still be used throughout the school day?**

Yes. The Physical Education uniform remains the daily sports uniform worn to school on Physical Education days and on ACS Sport and Year 5 and 6 Sport days. The Competitive Sportswear uniform must be worn in full during all periods of competition.

### **Can students wear match uniforms to school?**

No. Match uniforms must not be worn as general school or Physical Education attire. Students should arrive in their Physical Education uniform. When travelling to fixtures, students may change into their match uniform prior to departure or upon arrival. The match uniform must be worn in full while competing, including when on the sidelines or not actively in play.

# Purchasing the Uniform

## Where can families purchase the new Competitive Sportswear Range?

## What if the uniform does not fit?

Students should try on garments carefully before removing tags. If the sizing is not suitable, items with tags still attached may be returned or exchanged in accordance with the Uniform Group's return policy.

## Can students choose their own number on numbered jerseys?

No. Where a uniform includes numbered jerseys, numbers cannot be selected or reserved by families. Numbers will be allocated based on stock availability and at the discretion of the retail staff at the time of purchase.

## What sports are in Phase 1

Phase 1 of the Competitive Sportswear Range rollout focuses on sports that previously had their own distinct competition uniforms rather than using the standard Physical Education uniform.

The following sports are included in Phase 1:

### **Year 5 and 6 Sport**

- Australian Rules (girls and boys)
- Basketball (girls and boys)
- Soccer (girls and boys)

### **ACS Sport**

- Australian Rules (girls and boys)
- Basketball (girls and boys)
- Hockey (boys only)
- Netball (girls only)
- Senior School Futsal (girls and boys)
- Soccer (girls and boys)

### **Premier Teams**

- Athletics and Cross Country (girls and boys)

Additional sports will be introduced in future phases as the College continues to review the Parameters of Wear and expand the Competitive Sportswear Range where appropriate.

# What items are permitted and not permitted?

## **Can the 'Red Hoodie' be worn with the Competitive Sportswear Range?**

No. The red hoodie is not permitted to be worn with the Competitive Sportswear Range while competing.

It may be worn with the Physical Education uniform on ACS Sport and Year 5 and 6 Sport days when students are not competing, including in transit.

## **Can students mix items from different sports?**

Competition uniforms must be worn as a complete set and should not be mixed with items from other sports.

Some items, such as socks or multipurpose tops, may be used across multiple sports. Families should refer to the Parameters of Wear document to confirm which items are permitted.

## **What cut options are available when selecting uniform items?**

Uniform items are available in three cuts: Men, Women and Youth.

## **Can students personalise or alter their sports uniform?**

No. Competition uniforms must not be altered or personalised. Students should wear the uniform as issued and must not modify garments, such as rolling shorts waistbands, cutting socks, or adding patches, logos, or other alterations.

## **Can students wear club sportswear or non-school items with the uniform?**

No. When representing Overnewton, students must wear the approved College uniform only. Club apparel, generic sportswear, and non-school outerwear are not permitted during matches.

## **What should students wear under their match uniform?**

Where required, students may wear base layers. These must be plain white and must not display visible branding.

## **Do students need to wear the full uniform for every match?**

Yes. When representing Overnewton, students are expected to wear the complete approved uniform for their sport, including the correct top, shorts or skirt, and socks.

# Additional Questions

## **Will more sports be included in the future?**

Yes. This rollout represents Phase 1 of the Competitive Sportswear Range release and focuses on replacing sports that previously had their own unique uniforms separate from the Physical Education uniform. The College will continue to review the Parameters of Wear and may introduce performance uniforms for additional sports where appropriate.

## **What happens if my child joins a team partway through the season?**

Students who join a team during the season will still be required to wear the approved match uniform for that sport. Families will be able to purchase the required items through the [Uniform Group](#).

## **What happens if my child is reallocated to a different sport?**

During the selection process, students may be required to reselect or be allocated to a different sport. All items must remain in original condition, with tags attached and unworn. Uniform Group will facilitate exchanges for the appropriate items required for the new sport, in line with their exchange policy.

## **Will my child need a different uniform for every sport?**

In some cases, yes. The competitive sportswear range has been designed so that each sport has garments suited to the specific demands of that activity.

The College has worked hard to balance performance and comfort with the cost to families. Some items, such as socks and multipurpose tops, may be used across multiple sports where appropriate. Students will only need to purchase the garments required for the sport(s) in which they are representing the College.

## **What if I am unsure which sport my child is playing?**
