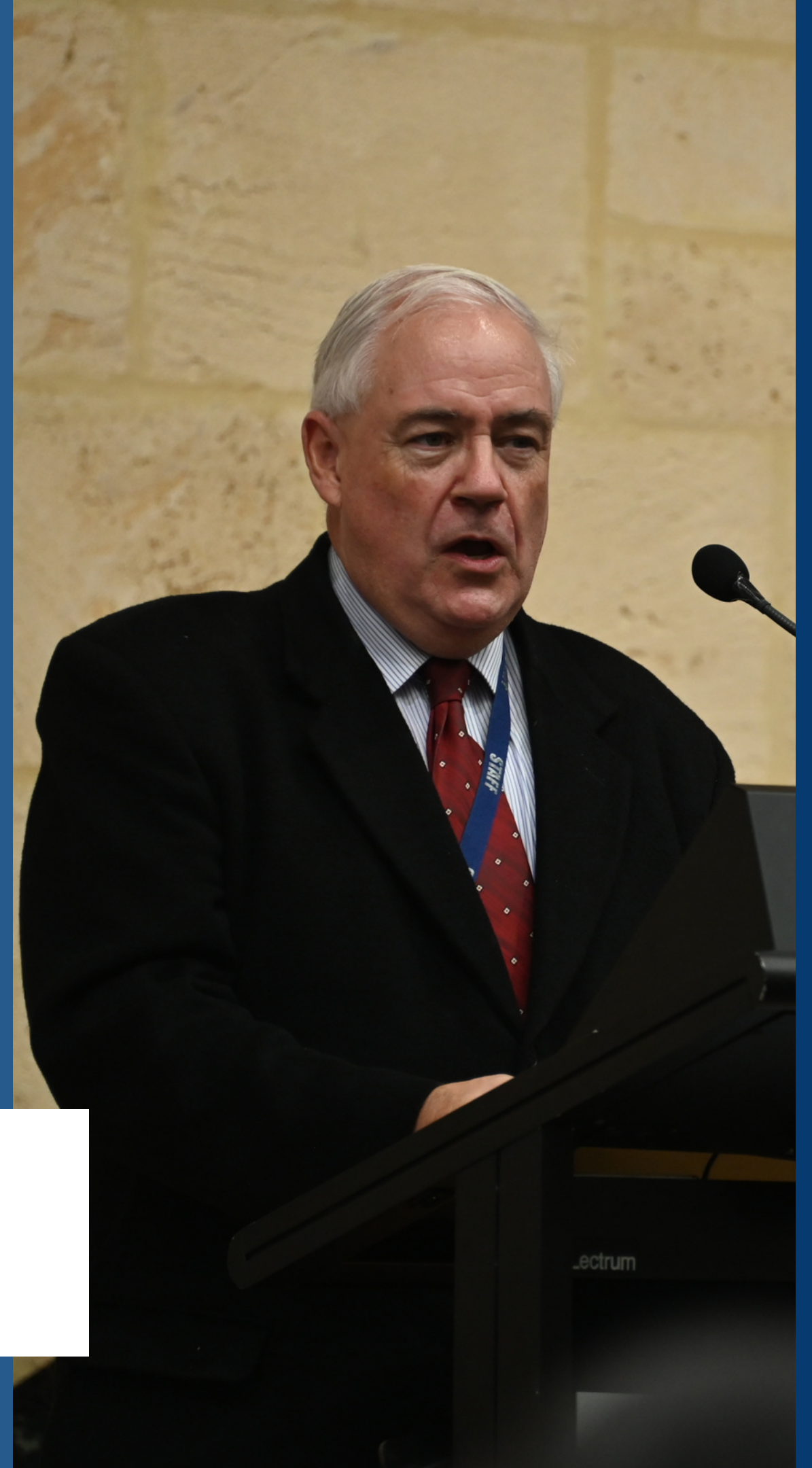
THURSDAY 2 MAY 2024 - Week 3

Presentation from Heritage Coordinator, Mr John Beaverstock, at the Senior School Assembly about Heritage Week and the theme. We will also have a special guest Old Saints' speaker Charles Street (1998), who founded Inkwazi Adventures.

Inkwazi Adventures partners with not-for-profit Elephants, Rhinos & People (ERP) on the BIKES4ERP program, which has so far provided bicycles to over 500 students in South Africa. Inkwazi Adventures is a past recipient of the Old Saints' Service & Endeavour Award.

The Old Saints' Service & Endeavor Award, launched in 2018, has donated more than \$25 000 to former students with a desire to engage in charitable or beneficent work nationally and overseas.
