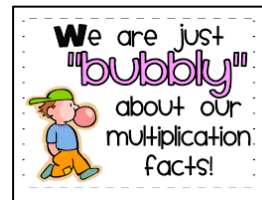

5. The **PRODUCT** of two numbers is 42. If one of those numbers is 14, what is the other number?



6. A taxi leaves an airport and travels 1 kilometre north, 3 kilometres west, 1 kilometre north, and 3 kilometres east. How many kilometres is the taxi from the airport now, “as the crow flies”?



7. Two TV morning shows are fighting for ratings at the moment. “**TODAY**” on channel 9 had 177,000 viewers last Wednesday. On that same day, “**SUNRISE**” on channel 7 had 301,000 viewers. What was the **SUM** of those viewer numbers, and what is the **DIFFERENCE** between them?



8. The TV program “**MY KITCHEN RULES**” had a TV audience of 816,000 on one night last week. At the same time, Channel 10s “**I’M A CELEBRITY . . .**” had 676,000 viewers. How many **MORE** viewers did “MKR” have than “Celebrity”?

9. Jenny has 6 cuddly toys. Her friend Tanya has twice as many. How many cuddly toys do the two girls have in total?



10. **Open-ended Question:** Ray has 3 shapes in a box. Altogether the shapes have 11 straight sides. What might those shapes be?
