An exciting Pupil Free Day program has been organised including a trip to Social Fair at 14 Smethurst Street Cranbourne. Whilst at Social Fair the students can engage in fun and physical activities whilst trying new movements with their bodies. We will be travelling to Social Fair in a seat belted bus, leaving school at **10:00am** and returning around **2:20pm**. Students must be at school by 9:30am as we leave at 10:00am and cannot wait for late arrivals. Students can wear free dress for the day, but we recommend that pants/shorts are a better option. **Runners must be worn.**

Each student must bring their own food which includes morning, lunch, and afternoon snacks for the day. Please remember not to include **nuts or nut products**. Students will need a drink bottle which can be refilled with water. We **will not** be offering breakfast on this day; students will need to have this before they arrive.

When we return to school after such a busy day, we will have some activities including outside play with our sport equipment, drawing, colouring, dressing up, home corner, board games, Lego, and dolls.

The cost for the day is \$70 and bookings are essential. All bookings are to be made by completing and signing the permission on the back of this form and returning it to school.

The Pupil Free Day Program will only run if sufficient numbers book. If the program is not able to run due to insufficient numbers, parents will be notified via compass Thursday 8th May. Confirmation that the program will go ahead will appear in the newsletter and on compass. The maximum number of children who can attend is 45, with 3 educators. A risk assessment has been prepared and is available at the service along with the bus route.

If your child is attending our Pupil Free Day Program, please ensure that:

- The student is currently enrolled in Outside School Hours Care(Before and After care)
- You are signed up for Smartcentral
- You are signed up for Childcare Easy Pay
- Signed booking form is returned by due date
