

Additional Information

CASUAL DAYS

On casual days students can wear clothing appropriate with the theme of casual day. However students are still expected to observe sun safety rules, when outside, by wearing appropriate hats and clothing.

MAKE UP

Make up is not permitted at school, this includes nail polish.

JEWELLERY AT SCHOOL

Small items of jewellery such as studs and sleepers are acceptable. Items such as chunky bracelets and necklaces need to be kept for special occasions and are not part of the school dress code.

MOBILE PHONES

If students need to bring mobile phones to school the phone must be turned off on entry into the school grounds and cannot be turned on until the end of the school day when the child leaves the classroom. Any student found disobeying this policy will have his/her mobile phone confiscated immediately and returned at the conclusion of the school day. Emergency messages for students need to be forwarded through the school's office.

HAIR ACCESSORIES

Hair ribbons, headbands and hair ties must be School Colours, Navy, White or Sky Blue.

Whilst our phase in period has ended for the introduction of the new tri-colour polo shirt, families with children still wearing the old style plain colour polo shirts may continue to do so until they need replacing.

LOST PROPERTY

Please make sure that your children's belongings are named clearly. If articles of clothing, lunch boxes, containers, etc. are lost, check the lost property boxes that are located in each building. Only named articles are left for collection or returned to the owner. At the end of each term all unnamed and uncollected items will be donated to charity.

At Lockleys North Primary School students are expected to respect our school dress code and wear our school uniform at all times. The Governing Council has approved this policy and request that parents and staff support it.

The uniform provides all students and families with a sense of community and pride in being identified as a Lockleys North student.

The uniform has been selected to incorporate functionality and practicality in consideration of a healthy, active lifestyle ethos incorporated in the school curriculum.

The school uniform items consist of:

LNPS Polo Shirt (short sleeve and long sleeve)
Year 7 Polo Shirts
Year 7 Windcheaters
Baseball Jackets
Hats
Iron on Logos

These items can be purchased from the school's "Topshop" or via a Uniform Order Form available from the shop, the office or from the school website.



LNPS Polo Shirt - Short Sleeve and Long Sleeve

Our Polo Shirt incorporates the three School Colours, navy blue, sky blue and white. The shirts have the School Name embroidered into the Collar.

Year 7 Short Sleeve Polo Shirts

There is a special polo shirt available to Year 7 students only. It identifies them as senior students in the School. The shirt can only be purchased through a special order. An order form is sent home to all Year 6 students in Term 3. Payment and orders are due back at the end of Term 3 and students receive the order in Term 4. These are not a stock item at the Topshop.



Year 7 Windcheaters

Every year a special windcheater is produced with the names of the current year 7 students. The style of windcheater and design remains the same each year with the font styles being selected by the class itself. All Year 7 students are strongly encouraged to purchase one of these windcheaters.

Baseball jacket

A zip up jacket with long sleeves. The jacket is navy blue and sky blue with the school logo. It is popular with younger students especially.

Hats and Beanies

LNPS has a hat policy in line with the Cancer Council of SA recommendations/guidelines. Hats are compulsory for Term 1 and Term 4 and part of Term 2 and Term 3, (30th April – 1st Sept) Students can still wear hats all year round. Navy Beanies can be worn in winter.

Iron on Logos

Iron on logos, for application to plain navy windcheaters, are available at any time from the front office and the Topshop.

Please note: Black or white pants and denim jeans are not permitted.

The following uniform items can be purchased at local school wear shops and retailers, please see overleaf for our preferred supplier's details:

Navy windcheaters or jumpers
Navy pants (long or three quarter length). No logos /stripes
Navy cargo pants. No logos / stripes
Navy shorts
Navy skirts or skorts
Blue and white summer check dress
Navy beanie (Term 2&3only)
Navy, sky blue or white accessories (eg. headbands)

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

Shoes:

School footwear needs to be suitable and safe, such as sneakers or closed school shoes. Thong-like shoes and thin canvas materials are inappropriate.

Sunglasses:

Sunglasses may be worn outside.

Scarves:

Scarves can be worn if in school colours. However they are not a stock item at the Topshop.

Physical Activities:

There is no specific PE uniform.

Art Smocks:

Junior Primary students are encouraged to have one at school; however they are not a stock item at the Topshop.
