Here are some examples of the excursions and incursions we have had during the July school holidays!

<u>Pyjama Day:</u>

The children enjoyed the day dressing up in their Pj's and played party games. Pass the parcel, musical statues, red rover all over, limbo & pin the bow tie on the penguin. They also enjoyed eating yummy party food including pizza, spring rolls, nuggets, pies & pasties and sausage rolls. All the children spent the afternoon dancing away to their favourite party songs.



<u>Mini Golf:</u>

The children had fun playing mini golf with their friends in the gym. There were 9 different stations, some more challenging than others including curves, hills, tricky thin sections and one over a bridge. The children were very proud of themselves once they accomplished all the stations.



<u>Beachouse Glenelg:</u>

The children enjoyed the day playing arcade games, car racing, dance challenge, mini basketball, bumper cars, mini golf, the indoor playground and going for a ride on the train and merry-go-round. We had lunch under the rotunda and then played: roll down the hill, cartwheels, red rover and gymnastics on the grass. This was our most popular excursion !



Kids Cooking Day at Marion:

The children attend a cooking class at Marion Shopping Centre, where they experienced hands on cooking. Children learnt how to make protein balls by measuring and combining ingredients, mixing and rolling into balls and then coating in coconut. They also had the opportunity to make ice cream. Once the children finished cooking they played some games using the foam blocks and noodles.
