The Victorian School Building Authority will continue to assist Scoresby Secondary College with infrastructure upgrades and planned maintenance works to ensure all affected areas are returned to normal operations.

MAKE SAFE WORKS

The Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA) has been working closely with Scoresby Secondary College since January 2018 to address structural damage which appeared in internal and external brickwork, in various areas of the school's buildings.

The VSBA's Planned Maintenance Program allocated funding to the school in November 2018 to address structural damage in some specific areas in the North and South Wings, to rectify cracking and movement in the perimeter walls.

As a result of subsequent investigations which were part of this process, the VSBA has extended the scope of works. This will address the entire perimeter wall systems to the North and South main building wings, and include repair works to the Resource Centre.

Next Steps

The VSBA is working with the school and contractors to confirm the details of the scope, which is in final design stages.

Once confirmed, the school will receive a full briefing of the approach and design documentation – this will then be put to tender to procure a main builder.

The tender process will take approximately three weeks, with the wider project expected to be completed in 12 to 18 months.

The VSBA will continue to work closely with Scoresby Secondary College to ensure that the affected areas are returned to operational capacity, safely and within the scheduled timeline.
