

Nestled at the heart of the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron in Manly, the PMSA Sailing program is a dynamic and exhilarating initiative crafted to introduce students to the captivating realm of sailing.

The PMSA Activities Sailing Program is designed to offer a unique and enriching experience for students in Years 6-12 who attend Brisbane Boy's College, Clayfield College, and Somerville House. Whether you are new to sailing or an experienced sailor, the program will cater to a wide range of skill levels – from development squads to racing teams. The program is scheduled to run every Sunday in Term 4 and Term 1.

Learn to Sail

Prior to participating in races, students must have successfully completed a Learn to Sail course. These courses are readily available through RQYS (Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron) or DPSS (Darling Point Sailing Squadron). Learning to sail involves the completion of Tackers 1 and 2 or Start Sailing 1 and 2 (depending on the child's age).

Sailor Requirements

Land uniform: PMSA Activities sailing polo shirt and PMSA Activities sailing cap.

On water: PMSA Activities sailing long sleeve, school sports shorts or personal wetsuit, PMSA Activities sailing cap and PMSA Activities sailing bib.

Sailing Registration

To enrol your child in sailing activities, please complete the PMSA Activities Sailing Program Registration Form <u>HERE</u>. Students will not be permitted to engage in sailing, whether for training or competition, until a signed permission form has been sent to <u>sailing@pmsa-schools.edu.au</u>. The Sailing Levy for each term (Term 4, and Term 1) is \$620, which covers expenses such as boat storage, competition entry fees, pacer maintenance, coaching fees, and fuel for coach boats.

All sailors are required to register via the PMSA Activities Sailing Program registration form and make payment following the steps provided on the form or via email each term.
