The Grade 5/6 students will soon be undertaking an educational tour of our nation's capital. They will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. The Australian Government recognises the importance of young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion, the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$30 per student, under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid to the school upon completion of the excursion.

This covers all bus travel to and around Canberra, entry to all attractions, accommodation and meals every day as well as the rebate. Payment is to be paid in full, before the camp. Please contact Bree in the office for any queries regarding payments.

(Students will be required to bring their own lunch on the first day)
