
STEM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2026

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students selected for this scholarship program will participate in a dedicated 60 minute weekly session as part of a group of 8-10 students from years 4-6. Sessions will run after lunch at the Buninyong Campus. Transportation for Scotsburn students will be provided as required. We expect this scholarship group will at times go off site for excursions.

This program will be led by Jordon Smith, our current STEM teacher. This scholarship Program will help students build their capacity to in all areas of STEM and provide an extra opportunity to apply their interest in this area.

For this scholarship program, we're looking for students with a passion for STEM.



SELECTION CRITERIA

- Demonstrated commitment to the school's values (Respectful, Responsible and Kind)
- A demonstrated passion for all areas of STEM.
- Excellent results in school based reports and assessment in the area of STEM.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with others

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students currently in grades 3, 4 and 5 are now invited to apply for a spot in the 2026 STEM Scholarship Program. Students from both campuses are invited to apply, including those that have been part of the program in 2025. The closing date for applications is Friday November 28.

To apply, students need to write a letter explaining why they would like to be participate and why they should be selected. Students are also invited to include extra documents that demonstrate their interest and capabilities related to STEM.

Whilst students can apply for 2 or more scholarship programs, they can only be selected for 1.

Please submit applications to the office staff. We do expect each of the scholarship programs will be over-subscribed, so making the effort to submit a quality application will be important.
