1). Each competitor can be accompanied by 1 adult only in the session period ( 30 minutes) with a maximum of 8 participants .

2). Entry to the CWA Orange Venue is via the front door in Robertson Park;

<u>3). Covid-19 Marshalls will be present to check.</u> Adults into the premises via the Services NSW CWG QR code;
Adults and telephone numbers recorded for insurance purposes.

## HINTS AND GUIDELINES FOR SPEAKERS

- INTRODUCTION: The Chairman will announce both the Entrant and the chosen topic. Entrants will use the form of address, 'Madam Chairman'. (All the chairmen will be CWA members, thus female, but we always try to include at least one male in the 3-person judging panel.)
- TIMING will begin when the Entrant has said 'Madam Chairman'. A warning bell will be rung 30 seconds prior to the end of the time limit.
- USE OF NOTES, PALM CARDS: Their use is up to the competitor; the best cards have only a few key words on them, to jog the Speaker's memory. The notes / cards should be small enough to not get between the Speaker and his / her audience and not distract the audience.
- PRESENTATION: Students need to know that this is a SPEAKING competition- they will not be judged on their ability to memorise their speeches, or to dramatise them. The criterion for judging is based on the Entrant being natural, familiar with what they want to say and talking comfortably with their audience.
