

We cannot wait for the Colour Run to happen at our school **this Friday 21st November!** The forecast is looking great and it's sure to be a wonderful day.

We are excited to share that Parents & Friends will also be running food sales at lunch time to add to the fun of the day – these will be over the counter snack sales. Please see all of the details on the attached flyer.

All students need to have consent via the Compass Event to participate. If you have not yet consented in the Event and wish for your child to participate, please do so before the day.

What to wear?

Students are to come to school in their Colour Run clothes. Students need a white t-shirt, along with shorts/pants. These can be school shorts/pants or casual, but please note that there will be coloured powder thrown, as well as water and foam stations. Please select items of clothing that you're ok having coloured powder, water and foam on. This includes shoes, too. Students still require a hat, and jumpers can be removed before the event. They may like to pack a jumper to put on afterwards that is ok if colour transfers onto it.

At school on the day, all students will receive a Colour Run headband and sunglasses to wear as part of the fun! The students can keep these items.

Does my child need a change of clothes?

This is up to you, they can but it's not a requirement. Remember a bag to put coloured clothes into if you choose to do this. You may also like to pack a towel, or put one in the car, to sit on if travelling home from school via car to avoid any colour transferring to your seats.

What time is the Colour Run taking place?

The Colour Run is taking place from 11:30am onwards. From 9-11am, students will be in class as per normal. Then, following recess, the event will begin. Our amazing team of volunteers, along with Australian Fundraising, will be here setting up in the morning.

Each year level will run the course together – each year level will get to run two laps of the course. Students are able to bypass any stations they don't wish to go past.

Each year level will have the opportunity to run the course, spectate and cheer another year level on as they run the course, as well as participate in a series of student led outdoor games and activities. Year levels will rotate through spectating the event, running the course, and participating in the games and activities.

All year levels will have completed the Colour Run course prior to lunch time.



During lunch time, the music will continue and Parents & Friends will be running over the counter food sales for students to buy snacks from if they'd like to (see attached flyer for details).

After lunch time, all students will get to watch the sliming take place. We have had an incredible number of staff members volunteer to be slimed! We just know our students will love watching and cheering our staff members on as this takes place. Our top individual fundraisers across year levels will get to do the sliming!

Following the sliming, the students will come together to finish off the day with a fun activity outdoors altogether.

Students will be dismissed as per normal at 3:30pm.

Can I come and watch the Colour Run?

Parents/carers are very welcome to come and watch the event take place. The oval area will be very busy with the course set up, and students spectating, or participating (games/activities will be taking place on the asphalt area), so we ask that parents/carers that have come to watch the fun please stand on or near the oval stage area. There will also be gazebos set up in the centre of the oval that students will be spectating from, so you are also welcome to watch from the centre of the oval, too.

Year levels will be running at different times. If you'd like to come and watch, please find the approximate time below (please note, this may run slightly behind or ahead of schedule):

12:00pm – Prep

12:15pm - Year 2

12:30pm - Year 4

12:45pm - Year 1

1:00pm - Year 3

1:15pm – Year 5

When can my child fundraise until?

When will fundraising prizes be delivered?

Following fundraising closing on the evening of Friday 21st November, families then have 7 days to log onto their profile and select their prizes or make a donation. We will send out further details about this step next week. Prizes will then be delivered to the school and distributed by the Colour Run volunteer team
