

# **OLA Sport Carnival Protocols 2019**

These protocols are being shared with the OLA Community to inform when and how each of the major sporting events are conducted over the school year. They provide clear guidelines for each event.

While competition is valued, the emphasis is on participation and the development of good sportsmanship. Students are strongly encouraged to participate in all events contributing to their faction on each given day. Students can strive for and show Respect, Integrity, Compassion and Excellence through each of these sporting events.

OLA has moved in line with other CPSSA Schools and replaced our third place, second place and first place medals for Swimming and Athletics with Championship and Runner Up trophies. In general, these will be presented at the conclusion of each carnival.

## Junior Swim Fun Day (Years 1-2)

**Venue: Terry Tyzack Aquatic Centre** 

Date: 13/3/19

• Students will participate in fun water activities in a non-competitive environment.

# Senior Swimming (Years 3-6) - 14/3/19

**Venue: Terry Tyzack Aquatic Centre** 

Date: 14/3/19

- Parents return pro forma that indicates which events they would like their child to enter and which stage/squad level they are in at present;
- Please only enter children in events they can complete;
- Students are placed in divisions according to their stage/squad level in conjunction with past year's results i.e. Interschool selection;
- Individual points for Years 4-6 champions are based on times from 50m events in Freestyle, Backstroke and Breaststroke. In addition, 50m Butterfly and 100m Freestyle for Year 5 and 6 students;
- For Year 3 students only 25m Freestyle, Backstroke and Breaststroke are eligible for championship points;
- Please note that ALL races and all places contribute to Faction Points;





#### **OUR LADY'S ASSUMPTION**

- Any student in Year 4 who is capable of completing 50m Butterfly, who would like to compete in this event needs to see Mrs Stewart as soon as possible;
- The Endeavour Trophy and Faction Trophy will be presented at the conclusion of the day;
- Students will be selected to represent OLA at the CPSSA Swimming Carnival in Term 2, according to the four fastest times for 50m Freestyle, Backstroke and Breaststroke per year group. The 50m Butterfly and 100m Freestyle are open events. Relay team members will be selected based on the fastest times.

## **Junior Cross Country (Years PP -2)**

**Venue: Waverley Reserve** 

Date: 18/6/19

Students compete in gender races for the following distances

Pre-Primary -300m Year 1 -600m Year 2 -600m

- Place getters will receive a place ribbon at the conclusion of the event;
- All students receive a participation ribbon.

# Senior Cross Country (Years 3-6)

**Venue: Dianella Regional Open Space** 

Date: 25/6/19

Students compete in gender races for the following distances

Year 3 -1.2km Year 4 -1.5km Year 5 -2km Year 6 -2km

- Medals will be presented to students finishing in first, second and third place at the conclusion of the event;
- The first six students to cross the finish line in the OLA event will then represent OLA at the CPSSA Cross Country event in Term 3 (30/7/19).

# Winter Sports and Sacred Saints Tournaments

Venue: Various TBC Date: 20/6/19

- All Year 6 students will participate in these CPSSA events in Term 2;
- Students choose which sport they would like to play (Football, Netball or Soccer);



• Teams may be adjusted to accommodate numbers.

#### **Pre-Primary Athletics**

**Venue: Dianella Regional Open Space** 

Date: 17/10/19

- Students are placed into races and games based on their class;
- The focus of the day is participation;
- Students are participating in events between approximately 10:00am till 11:30am.

### **Junior Athletics (Years 1-2)**

Venue: Dianella Regional Open Space

Date: 17/10/19

- Students will be placed into divisions for races during Physical Education lessons at school. This will be done multiple times to ensure children are placed into the appropriate races;
- Students remain at the carnival for the entire day and participate in team games and individual races.

## **Senior Athletics (Years 3-6)**

**Venue: Dianella Regional Open Space** 

Date: 17/10/19

- Students in Years 3-6 will participate in trials at Noranda Sporting Complex at the end of Term 3 (23/9/19);
- Students are placed into divisions for Sports Day according to time i.e. fastest 1-8 A division, 9-16 B division, 17-24 C division, 24-32 D division;
- Students will compete in field events (Shot Put, Turbo Javelin and Discus) during lesson time. Long Jump will take place on the same day as the Trials at Noranda;
- Individual points for Age Champions are based on:
  - Places for all 4 field events, Long Jump, Discus, Shot Put and Turbo Javelin. These measurements are taken during lesson times in Weeks 5, 6 and 7 of Term 3.
  - All A Division track events 75m/100m, 200m, 400m and the 800m for Years 5 and 6 students.
- Students will be selected for the CPSSA event in Term 4 based on the following results:
  - First and second place for field events of Long Jump, Turbo Javelin and Shot Put.
  - First to fourth for sprint events (75m/100m, 200m), first and second place for the 400m per year group per gender and only two competitors in the open 800m.



## **Athletics Exemptions-**

- If students are absent for the Athletic Trials and an alternate trial cannot be arranged, they will be placed in the division that they raced in, in the previous year's carnival.
- If they are absent for the carnival, but record faster times in the trials, then they will be considered for Interschool selection. This will be at the teacher's discretion.

### **Summer Carnival**

**Venue: Noranda Sporting Complex and Yokine Reserve** 

Date: 15/11/19

- All Year 5 students will participate in this CPSSA Carnival in Term 4. Students choose which sport they would like to play
  - o Tennis
  - Cricket
  - Ultimate Frisbee
- Teams may be adjusted to accommodate numbers.
