RMIT University, Melbourne 28–30 June 2022

Budding scientists entering Year 9 or 10 in 2022 will work together to problem solve real world challenges in laboratories and state-of-the-art facilities in disciplines such as space science, nanotechnology, biomedical science, food science, allied health sciences and engineering. Interactive activities, excursions and guest lectures will provide attending students with an invaluable opportunity to learn from academic experts, and friendly RMIT student mentors will be their guides throughout the program as they understand and experience the STEM landscape of 2022 and beyond. The RMIT University Science Experience gives students the opportunity to explore career paths in STEM, make like-minded new friends, and see what University is all about in a supportive, safe and exciting environment.

Swinburne University of Technology, Hawthorn 6–9 July 2022

Explore the universe in virtual reality, conduct experiments in our Chemistry labs and explore the applications of the world class Australian Synchrotron. Our three day program encourages curiosity and explores the never-ending possibilities of science.

With a focus on real-world applications, you'll meet leaders from the scientific community, work with innovative

KIOSC, Wantirna 18–20 July 2022

Students will complete STEM activities and experiences in Forensic Science, Chemistry, Biology, Psychology and Technology. As well as a Mission to Mars, where students complete a range of activities to investigate colonisation of the red planet including housing, virtual reality and robotics.
