

SPECIFIC YEAR 7 PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- First bell is at 8.37am on Monday and Friday to allow extra time for Assemblies. Tuesday to Thursday the first bell is at 8.42am. Students are expected to be at school by 8.30am each day. The school day concludes at 3.15pm.
- 2020 Senior School Swimming Carnival will be held on Tuesday 4 February.
- Year 7 Timetable: The College operates on a 10-day cyclic timetable with each day being made up of 6 x 53 minute periods. The academic year comprises two semesters. Students in Year 7 study a common curriculum experiencing a wide range of subjects.
