Position Summary:

The role of the Apprentice – Sports Turf Management is to support and learn, under the direct supervision of the Superintendent and wider Grounds team, to support the maintenance and upkeep of the Golf Course and Grounds at the Club.

Key Responsibilities and Objectives:

Under direct supervision:

- Work within a team environment, following instructions and completing works in a timely manner.
- Cutting greens, tees, aprons, fairways and rough.
- Changing holes as instructed.
- Raking bunkers.
- The safe and correct use of chemicals and herbicides when spraying greens and fairways etc.
- The safe and correct use of equipment including, tractors, chainsaws and whipper snippers etc.
- Planting trees and shrubs.
- Maintenance works as directed on the Bowling greens, tennis courts and motel.
- Performing irrigation repairs and general maintenance as required.

The incumbent can expect to be allocated duties, not specifically mentioned in this document, but within the capacity, qualifications and experience normally expected from persons occupying positions at this classification.
