Dear CEPS Families,

As we approach the end of Semester 1, I would like to share some important information regarding your child/ren's upcoming report.

From 2025, Victorian Government Schools are required to teach and report against the **Victorian Curriculum Version 2.0** in **English and Mathematics**. This change is designed to ensure that teaching and learning remain current, relevant, and aligned with the latest statewide educational standards.

As part of this transition, you will notice a small but important change in your child/children's Semester 1 2025 school report. As the achievement standards reported on have changed, **English and Mathematics reporting will show your child's/children's achievement against the standards,** *not* **progress**. This means that the reporting table provided within the report will *not* provide a visible representation of learning growth from Semester 2, 2025. For all reports following, progress will be shown against the single achievement standard.

In Mathematics, there have been further reporting changes. On your child's previous report, the teacher reported against the 3 strands of the achievement standard for mathematics (Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry, and Statistics and Probability). **Under the Mathematics Curriculum 2.0, your child's teacher will report against the achievement standard, providing a single, aggregated score.** This is because the updated curriculum introduces new achievement standards and progression pathways that are not directly comparable to the previous version.

We appreciate your understanding and support as we move forward with this important curriculum update. If you have any questions about your child's report or the curriculum changes, please don't hesitate to reach out.
