What is UNSW Portfolio Entry?

12 December

With UNSW Portfolio Entry, your pathway into university is unique - just like you.

UNSW Portfolio Entry includes

- Art & Design Portfolio Entry,
- Built Environment Portfolio Entry,
- Bachelor of Information Systems Admissions Scheme (BISAS) and the
- Faculty of Engineering Admissions Scheme (FEAS).

Here at UNSW, we want to reward your passion, creativity and potential to succeed in your degree area. That's why we offer UNSW Portfolio Entry, which gives you the opportunity to demonstrate your passion and talent, alongside your ATAR. If this sounds like you, we want to see your portfolio submission. It's an easy, online process, and can only ever boost your chances of admission. What you submit in your portfolio will depend on which degree you're interested in. Remember, your UNSW Portfolio Entry submission needs to be completed in addition to your UAC application. Please note, individual faculties may decide to open a second round to accommodate more applications after ATARs are released. The second round will be dependent on the number of places available in the program.

Portfolio Entry gives you the opportunity to demonstrate your passion and talent, alongside your ATAR. UNSW Portfolio Entry is one, easy online process. You'll select up to three degrees that you're interested in and be guided through what you need to submit. All domestic student high school leavers who are applying for an eligible degree and expecting an ATAR within 10 points of the lowest selection rank for your degree (unless otherwise stated).
