Science Pathways

- Year 10 Science is compulsory for all in Semester 1
- In Semester 2, students can choose to study up to two of the following options (or one or none):
 - Chemistry & Physics
 - Biology & Psychology
 - Chemistry & Biology.

To study Physics or Chemistry in Year 11, students will need to have studied an option that includes one or both these.

To study Biology or Psychology in Year 11, choose any Semester 2 option.

2027 Subject Selection Process
