INSTRUMENT HIRE INFORMATION

- Bairnsdale Secondary College has several instruments available for hire in the first year of learning. When students decide they wish to continue with their current instrument, they have the option of purchasing the instrument over the next two years, minus the \$200 hire fee. Instruments available for hire for one year are: Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone (Alto, Tenor), Trumpet, Trombone, Violin, Viola and Cello. Priority for the hiring of these instruments is given to Year 7 students and is subject to demand.
- Some larger, more expensive instruments are available to hire throughout a student's school life for \$200 per year(subject to change). These instruments are: French Horn, Oboe, Bassoon, Tuba, Euphonium and Double bass.
- The hire fee is used towards the routine maintenance of the instruments and the purchase of new hire instruments.
- School owned instruments are not covered by insurance off the school premises. It is strongly recommended that parents make their own arrangements to insure a hired instrument for accidental damage or loss outside of the school.

CONDITIONS OF INSTRUMENT HIRE

- 1. Students must exercise all reasonable care with the instrument. Any cost of repairs due to carelessness will be charged to the hirer.
- 2. Students are not to allow anyone else to use the hired instrument.
- 3. Insurance against damage or loss is the responsibility of the hirer.
- 4. The normal hire period is for one school year.
- Students hiring instruments can hire their instrument over the Christmas holidays if the 6. following year's enrolment and hire form have been completed. The form needs to be returned to the Music Coordinator and the hire fee of \$200 must be paid prior to the end of the school year.
- 7. All instruments hired from Bairnsdale Secondary College must be stored in the Music Centre Storeroom during school hours.
