## **Entry Forms Rules & Guidelines**

### **PENINSULA TEENAGE FASHION EXHIBITION Monday 19 October 2020**

The Peninsula Teenage Fashion Exhibition is an event that encourages excellence in students studying fashion, allowing students to showcase their artistic talent combined with practical and creative abilities. This exhibition provides an opportunity for students to design, construct and model their own fashion garments, a unique opportunity for them to develop their talent, self-esteem, ability to set and achieve goals, and boost levels of self-confidence.

#### **RULES**

1. The entrant agrees that:
  - The outfit submitted must be the entrant's own work.
  - They are undertaking secondary studies.
  - They will take all responsibility for the delivery and collection of garments.
2. A parent or guardian must give permission on the entry form for the student to enter.

Entry will not be deemed valid unless entry forms (parts 1, 2, 3a & b) are complete:

- Completed entry and consent forms returned for both designer and model (*if the model is not the designer*)
  - Fees must be paid prior to judging (**Fees are non-refundable**) N/A in 2020
  - All completed forms and fees N/A in 2020 are to be received by Dromana College no later than **Wednesday September 2020**. Cheques to be made payable N/A in 2020 to Dromana College.
  - The garment does not have to be completed by 4 September, only the required paperwork. Even if the garment details are not finalised, we can edit them on Judging Day - **Sunday 11 October** - when the completed garment is to be judged.
3. Garments are to be made available after the event for publicity purposes.
  4. A commercial pattern **may** be used as a template.
  5. The decisions of the judges shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
  6. **Models will not be provided!** Remember, students must make their own arrangements and a permission form for the model must be provided.
  7. There shall only be one designer per outfit, unless prior approval is considered and given by the organizing committee.
  8. The entrant categories are as follows:
    - **Casual/Day Wear** - this category covers general daywear outfits, such as sportswear, beachwear and leisurewear.
    - **Special Occasion Wear** - also known as 'after-five-wear', this category covers all garments or outfits that would be worn to formal events and special occasions.
    - **Fantasy Wear** - this category allows entrants to showcase their creative potential. Wearable art and costumes using unusual materials and unconventional construction methods are encouraged – let your imagination run wild.
    - **Refashion/Recycle** – this entirely new category allows entrants to use recycled garments, fabrics, hardware and more, to create an entirely different and unique outfit.
  9. Each entrant will be required to have the outfits pre-judging, which includes presentation of garments on **Sunday October 11** one week prior to enable the judges to reach a final decision on Monday 19 October. **For 2020 only**
  10. The outcome of the judging will be the property of the PTFE committee, and will not be released to any students or public until **Monday 19 October**.
  11. All garments to be collected from Dromana College after the event.
  12. Each entrant is required to model or provide a model to present their garment(s) in the final Parade on **Monday 19 October** and the prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the parade. N/A in 2020 **A Video of your garment and photos to be provided**
  13. The Peninsula Teenage Fashion Exhibition will not be liable for loss or damage to any garments or articles associated with this event, although all due care will be taken.

14. All outfits must be ironed and hung on a coat hanger and placed in a garment bag with the student's name and garment number on the outside, including accessories.

**15. Dromana College Parents and Friends' Association reserves the right of refusal for any garment not deemed appropriate, or which does not meet the set guidelines.**

### JUDGING

All four categories are judged on the catwalk one week prior to the event, conducted by an independent panel.

#### Casual and Special Occasion Wear

- Suitability of fabric and style for age and occasion
- Fit or hang of garment
- Coordination of colour choice and accessories
- Originality
- Flair/Style/Overall presentation

An example of the criteria used in the technical judging is below:

(Please note: *The Fantasy Wear section is not **technically** judged*)

Section 'A' Compulsory	Section 'B' Individual (Judges Select Only 5 criteria that are applicable to the garment)
Correct cut of fabric	1 Choice of fabric (suitability of design)
Seam finish	2 Fastenings/openings
Hem finish	3 Sleeves/ armholes/ cuffs/ collar/ neckline
Degree of difficulty	4 Facings/ bindings/ linings
Finishing off and neatness	5 Trim/ decoration/embellishments
	6 Hand sewing
	7 Originality

#### Fantasy Wear

- Use of Materials for construction of garment
- Unusual and inventive design of garment
- Visual effect

#### Refashion/Recycle

- Unique use of recycled materials to create a new and original design
