

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As digital technologies become increasingly integrated into education, we recognise both their immense value and the challenges they present. While computers and internet access offer powerful learning opportunities, they can also introduce distractions that hinder student focus and may allow access to inappropriate content.

To support responsible and effective use of technology, Wagga Wagga Christian College has introduced **Linewize**, a comprehensive suite of Child Cyber Safety software and Digital Wellbeing solutions. Linewize is currently installed on all College owned devices, including all the Year 7 student devices.

Linewize helps teachers manage distractions by identifying off-task behaviour and guiding students back to learning. This improves classroom focus, supports positive digital habits, and enhances overall learning outcomes. During school hours, teachers and our IT team can live monitor the screens of student devices that have Linewize installed.

After-hours, student device use is not managed or monitored by the College. However, Linewize may be activated by parents to provide protection beyond the classroom. This will give parents the ability to:

- Set up web content filtering for home and receive alerts when unapproved content is attempted to be accessed
- Set daily screen time limits for home
- Customise management of games and applications for home
- Pause internet access on student devices at home.

Linewize also helps remove any confusion and provides a stress-free solution for the new legislation around social media access for under-16s.

If you are a parent of a student in Years 8, 9, or 10, Linewize is **not** installed on these devices (as they are not owned by the College). We are excited to announce that Linewize is now available to be set up for all families and we invite parents to opt into the Linewize program. Having Linewize set up with parents and at school, provides a complete safety net for your child online and is one way that we partner with parents to ensure the safety of children.

Our IT team will handle the additional setup of the device at **no additional cost to families**, ensuring it is fully integrated into the College's protected network and ready for safe, focused learning at school and home. Given the concerns for ease of digital distraction, misuse and access to inappropriate content, we encourage all families with children in Years 8-10 to take up this offer.
