# ENGLISH AND INQUIRY LEARNING

Our upcoming Integrated Inquiry unit, "How can we work together to make decisions and take actions that are fair and responsible for everyone?", will focus on economics and business. Students will explore key concepts like needs vs. wants, the nature and meaning of work, what it means to be a volunteer, and ethics in business. Through the Earn and Learn program, students will have the opportunity to create and manage their own businesses, from designing products or services to handling finances and marketing. This hands-on experience will help them develop cooperation, realworld decision-making skills, and an understanding of how ethical practices influence business success.

## **ENGLISH**

This term, we are excited to start Literature Circles, where students will read books in small groups and engage in discussions about them. Each student will take on a different role, encouraging deeper thinking and collaborative conversations. As part of this, they'll bring home tasks related to their book, which need to be completed in preparation for the next lesson. Thanks for your support!

During the term, the students will focus on writing their leadership speeches. To support this, they will participate in an incursion designed to help them identify and develop their own leadership qualities.

# Religion

'Morality and Justice' will be a key focus of Religion this term where students will participate in discussions about moral choices raised in fables, scripture and societal dilemmas. They will explain the importance and biblical basis for Human Dignity and its relationship to Human Rights.

Students will write and connect a Prayer of Collect to a social justice issue. They will reflect on the biblical call to discipleship and Jesus' teachings in the Beatitudes.

In the lead up to Christmas, students will pursue a deeper understanding of the themes and message of Advent as they prepare for the celebration of Christ's birth.
