



## **Student Art Competition Entry Form**

### **Conditions of Entry:**

1. Artwork can be 2D or 3D and take the form of drawing, photography, painting, sculpture (including ceramics), textiles, collage, printmaking, or mixed media. It must not be larger than one metre in any direction.
2. Only ONE (1) entry per student is permitted.
3. Artwork must be created solely by the Oxley Christian College student who submits it. *No help from parents, friends, or teachers.*
4. Artwork must be original. *Copying and using other images as a reference is okay. Tracing or submitting work partially or fully created by someone else is not allowed.*
5. Artwork must be a recent work created for the 2025 Festival of the Arts and linked to the theme of **Flourish**. *The link can be subtle or explicit and can be further explained through the artist's statement.*
6. Artwork must be submitted complete and ready to display. Mounted and framed if applicable.
7. All submissions for the Festival of the Arts must reflect the Christian values of the College. Artists should keep in mind that families and students from Prep to Year 12 attend the Festival and appropriate content should be selected. We appreciate your help in keeping the exhibition enjoyable and suitable for all guests. For any questions, please contact Mrs Kelly or Mr Niemandt. The College reserves the right to not accept artworks that fail to meet these guidelines.
8. Entries must be submitted to Mrs Kelly (Junior School) or Mr Niemandt (Senior School) along with a completed entry form, no later than Tuesday 16 September in the second last week of Term 3.
9. First place and runner up prizes will be awarded per year level category (Prep-Year 2, Year 3-6, Year 7-9, Year 10-12) judged before the Festival, in addition to Junior School and Senior School *People's Choice* awards determined through visitor votes given on the day.
10. Upon entry, you agree for your artwork to be photographed and used for marketing purposes and/or to be reproduced and feature on the front of greeting cards which will be available for purchase by the school community.
