This program provides:

Program outcomes include:

- Students make informed career choices to access Vocational Education and Training (VET) options
- Students develop individual learning plans identifying courses and study options linked to their preferred careers

Students will develop skills and knowledge in:

- Write scripts
- Plan shot list to create short
- Use and maintain equipment such as cameras, sound equipment, lighting and computers
- Communication and storytelling skills

- Basic photo/video editing skills

- attending EPP school
- likely to benefit from exposure to a vocational pathway
