SAINTS SET UP BROTHER PAT TRIPLE HEADER TO REDEEM TRIPLE LOSS

SNESA will host Secret Harbour and the Cobras this Saturday May 25th, in what will be an opportunity to regain momentum and get their season back on track.

The day will also bring together past players and the club's ever-growing members and support base. An exciting day, growing in popularity, that will hopefully translate into three home wins for the saints.

It comes on the back of three losses over the weekend to Jandakot for the Reserves and League and against Warnbro for the Thirds.

In what was likely SNESA's second worst quarter of football of the year, the League team was taught a lesson in their first quarter at Atwell Reserve. A tardy warm up and injuries to three key players in the first quarter led to a 30 point deficit at quarter time.

The saints worked their way back into the game through some crucial moving of players, taking the lead late in the third quarter. However, the Jets fired back and kicked away, running out 28 point winners.

In the Thirds game, the saints burst out of the blocks early kicking the first three goals. The saints led all the way until mid-way through the last quarter. Warnbro slowly fought back and pegged back the lead, holding the saints to only two goals in the second half. The saints simply could not get first use of the ball and get the ball forward in the last quarter, going down by four points.

Earlier in the day, the Reserves had a tough day out against the top of the C3R ladder. With 7 changes this week trying to find chemistry was never going to be easy. Also, a tough opposition that was well structured didn't make the task any easier. The saints fell behind and never looked poised for a comeback, suffering their heaviest defeat

for the season.

The League team, who still sit in third spot will host C3 ladder leaders, Secret Harbour this week. While it will be a top five battle in the Reserves with the saints (5th) hosting Secret Harbour (3rd). The Thirds team sit a game and a half outside the top six with a healthy percentage. They will host the Cobras late in the day, seeking to stay in touch with finals.

All three teams have healthy percentages above 120% which means although a lot of things went wrong on the weekend, the saints are doing a lot of things right and they are looking for plenty of support from past players and current fans to get down this Saturday to Soklich and Co Oval in the Brother Patrick Memorial game.
