Good News Lutheran College Senior Years Examinations STUDENT INFORMATION

- 1. The exams will take place in the **Senior Years building (upstairs).** Any variations to this are shown on the examination timetable. Please check the venue and time of the exam carefully.
- 2. During the examination period, **you are only required to be at school when you have an exam scheduled** or if you have another school commitment (eg. Career interviews). However, you may study at school if this is more convenient. If this is the case, please note the following:
 - you are to work in SY104 (Year 11s) or SY105 (Year 10s) under the supervision of the Study Room teacher
 - you **MUST sign in** via the sign in sheet in SY104/SY105
 - you **MUST NOT leave school to go down to the shops** to get lunch, etc. and then return. (ie. When you leave school for the day, it is under the assumption you are NOT RETURNING to school).
- 3. **College uniform** is required whenever you are at school whether it be for an exam, to study or for another school commitment.
- 4. If you will be **absent** for an exam, please advise the College **by telephone** <u>before 8.45 am</u>. You will then be required to **provide a medical certificate** at your earliest convenience on your return to school.
- Assemble outside the SY building near the Poppy Garden ready for the exams at the following times:
 8:50 for 9:00 am, 11.00 for 11:10 am and 1:25 for 1:35 pm
- 6. You are to enter and leave the exam room without any talk and in an orderly manner.
- 7. All paper for writing in your exams will be provided by your subject teachers. Please check with all your subject teachers to confirm any special requirements for individual subjects.
- 8. Examinations are generally **100 mins** long, plus 10 mins for reading. The exceptions to this are indicated on the ExaminationTimetable. Your exam supervisor will indicate when you can begin writing.
- 9. **Mobile phones, smart watches** and other digital devices, must not be taken into the examination room. Please leave phones in your locker or in the tray provided outside the exam room. Make sure your phone and any alarms are switched off.
- 10. You may take a bottle of **drinking water** in a <u>clear container</u> into the examination room. No other food or drink is permitted.
- Calculators, pens, pencils, erasers, rulers etc are not provided, so make sure that you have all that you need with you. These should be placed in a clear plastic bag.
 Liquid paper/white out is not permitted. Removable covers and instruction manuals for calculators are not permitted. Any graphics calculator must be cleared, except for Mathematics.
- 12. CHARGE YOUR CALCULATOR AT HOME the night before your exam. Do not expect the school to provide a charging port for you on the day of the exam.
- 13. Books and notes (except according to the guidelines in VCE Mathematics examinations) are not to be taken into the exam room.
- 14. **Dictionaries** are permitted for all students in German and English exams only (not English language). There are no provisions for EAL students to have a dictionary in any other examination. Dictionaries will be provided by the school.
- 15. Inside the examination room, there is to be **complete silence** and **no communication of any kind between students** at any time. This includes while the examination papers are being collected.
- 16. If you need to go to the **toilet during an examination**, please raise your hand and wait for one of the supervisors to speak to you.

Only **one student at a time** will be permitted to be out of the examination room so you may need to wait your turn. Students <u>will not be allowed</u> to leave the room for the toilet in the <u>first 30 minutes and last 15 minutes</u> of the exam.

17. You are not permitted to leave the examination room until the set time has expired. If you finish a paper early, check your work thoroughly.

At the end of each examination, please ensure that the supervisor collects your examination paper(s).

18. Any student with a clash with an exam and a Unit 3/4 class should **discuss the clash with their class teacher**. If essential content or assessment is being covered in this lesson, they should contact the VCE Coordinator to **arrange to reschedule the exam to an alternative time**.
