



Buses replace trains on the Frankston and Stony Point lines

8.30pm Monday18 August to last serviceThursday 28 August



We're busy removing level crossings

We're making the Frankston Line level crossing-free by removing all 27 of the dangerous and congested level crossings by 2029 and building 17 new stations, improving safety, reducing congestion and allowing more trains to run more often.

We're removing the level crossings at McDonald Street in Mordialloc and Station Street in Aspendale by building new rail bridges. As part of the project, a new elevated premium station will be built in the heart of Mordialloc and will feature modern facilities, all-abilities access, improved lighting, public spaces and landscaping. Entrances at both ends will make accessing the station easier and more convenient.

Improvements to the local traffic network will then allow the level crossing at Bear Street to be closed to vehicles, creating a vibrant station precinct with safe access for pedestrians and cyclists.

Mordialloc will be boom gate free, with a vibrant new station precinct in 2026.






Between Cheltenham and Frankston

Train replacement bus services










S1 S2 S3 S4 Stopping all stations

Between Caulfield and Frankston



Platform 2 closed at Mordialloc Station

From **Friday 29 August to mid 2026**, Platform 2 will close at Mordialloc Station. Frankston Line trains will continue to run in both directions (To City / To Frankston) from Platform 1.

Mordialloc Station will remain open throughout most of the construction period. We'll communicate any changes in advance, including when buses replace trains.

Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.
