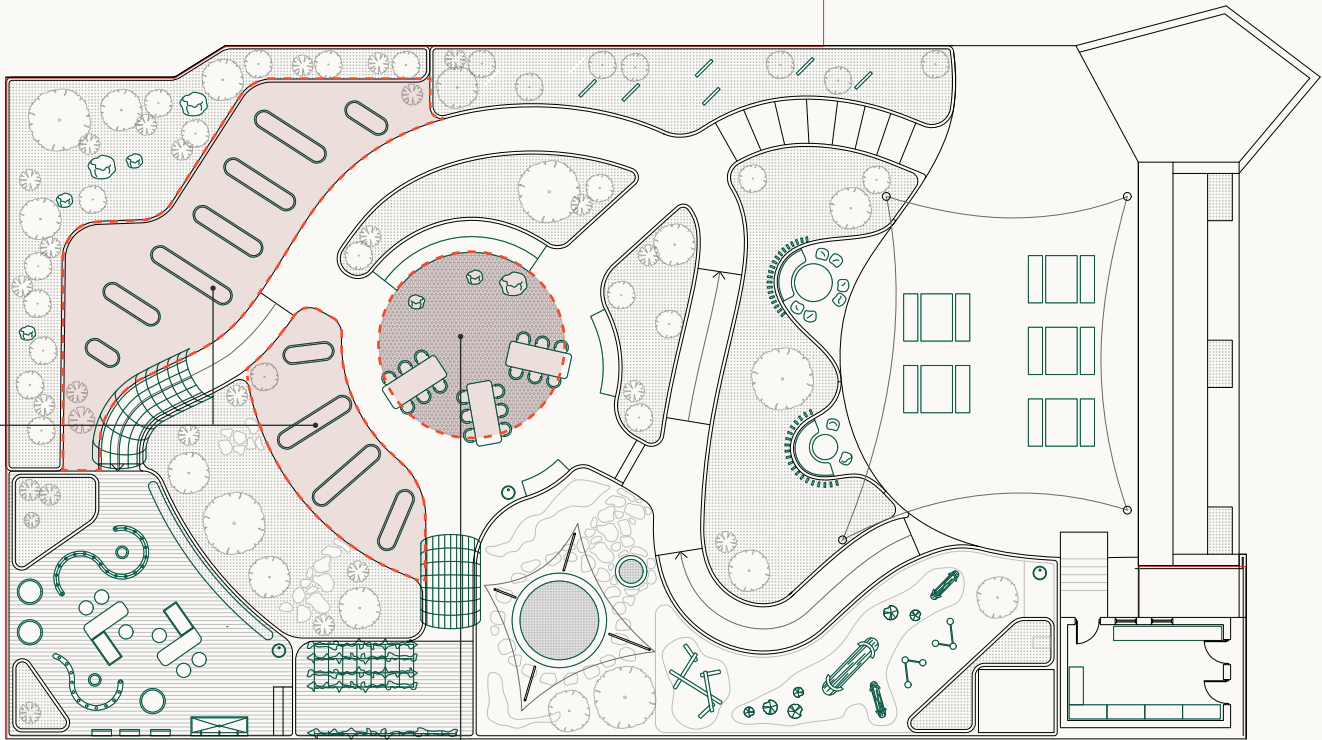


Activity Zones

Garden Stage / Productive Garden

Raise Planter

Raised planters support accessible, hands-on growing, with generous clearances between beds for wheelchair access and easy movement.



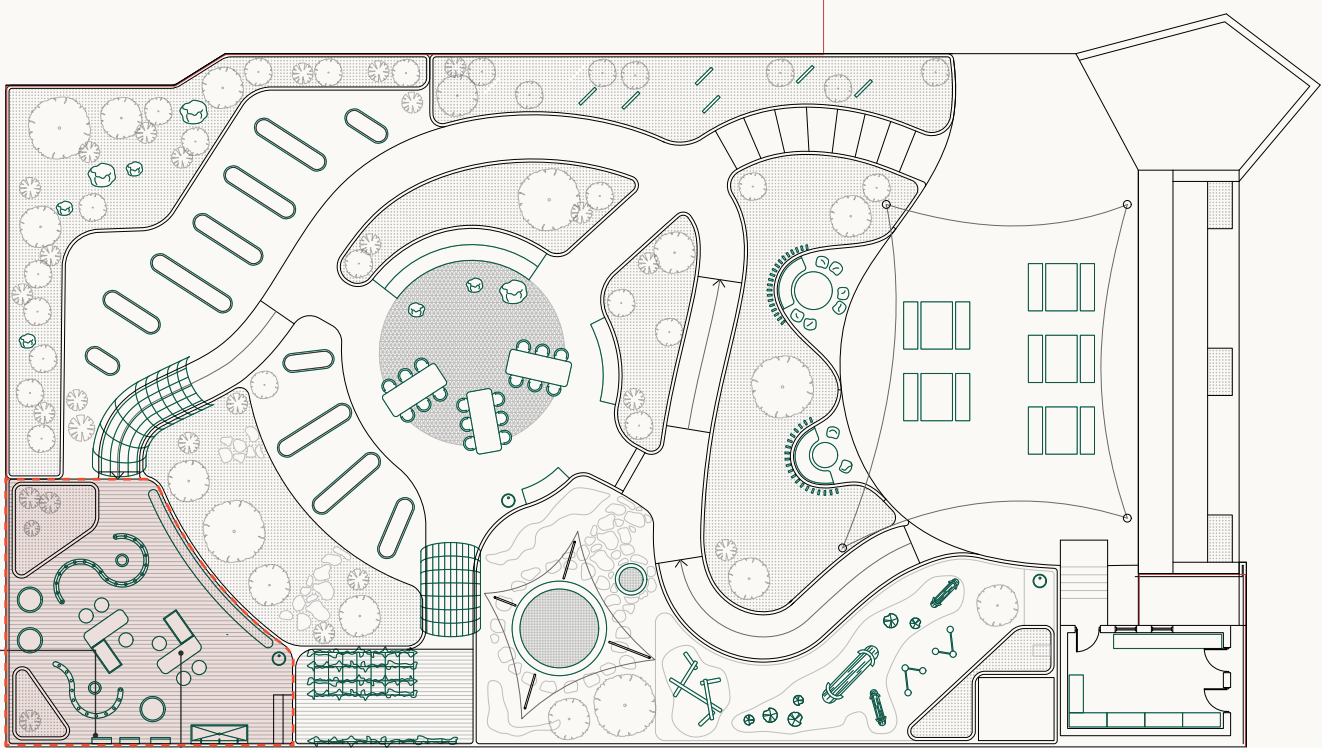
Garden Stage and Outdoor Classroom

Utilise the existing wall for seasonal climbing greenery, creating a living tunnel that offers a transitional moment and a learning opportunity around seasons and produce.



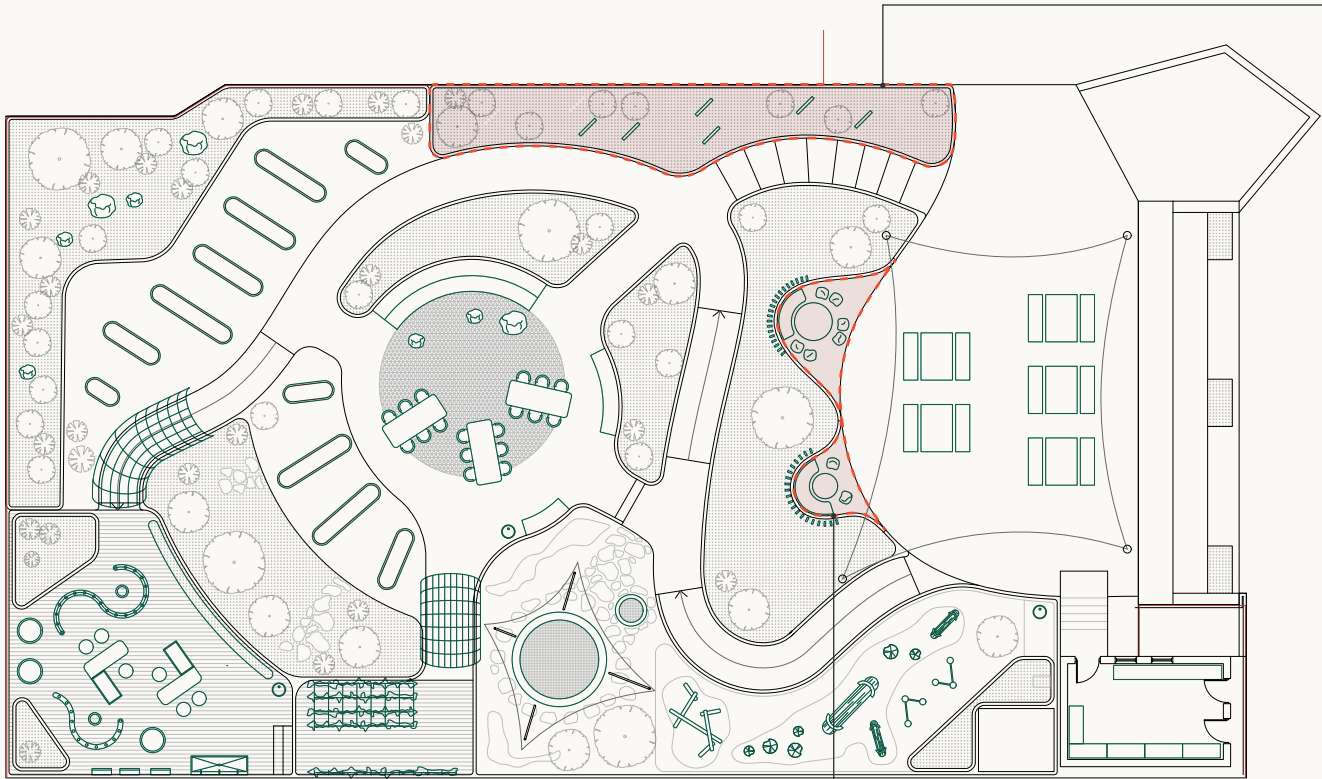
Sandpits and Playscape
