# SPECIAL EVENTS

#### **SWIMMING**

During Weeks 3 and 4 (16<sup>th</sup>– 26<sup>th</sup> October), the Year 3 students will participate in the school swimming program which will once again, be held at Mentone Grammar's swimming pool. Please ensure you have swimming attire ready to go (swimming cap, goggles, appropriate swimwear, towel, thongs/sandals).

## **CAMP**

In Week 7 (Monday 13<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November), we will be attending an overnight camp located in the Dandenong's. ### **EXCURSION**

Our unit of Inquiry in Term 4 is Science, with a specific focus on chemical sciences. We will be going to TwistEd Science in Moorabbin during Week 5 or 6. We look forward to this new and exciting experience for the students.

## **CURRICULUM UPDATE**

#### **LITERACY**

In reading, the students will be engaging in Literature Circles where they will read a novel selected by them, to discuss in a small group. We will be continuing to focus the skills of reading through fluency and accuracy tasks, as well as build the students' comprehension skills and expanding their vocabulary. In writing, the students will be exploring different mentor texts and continue practising the traits of writing. There will be a structural focus on procedural and explanation texts and forming paragraphs.

#### **NUMERACY**

The students will be continuing to build their understanding of multiplication strategies and building fluency with multiplication facts. Division will be a focus of the term, looking at the relationship between multiplication. In other areas, students will explore and revises concepts of capacity, mass, volume, time and shape. Lessons will include worded problems and problems solving tasks, as our continued approach to authentic mathematics learning.

## **INQUIRY**

Our Inquiry unit this term is Science, with a specific focus on chemical sciences. Our big question is, 'What has chemistry ever done for you?' The students will explore and demonstrate their understanding of the role chemistry plays in our everyday lives and therefore, how it is useful. Students will investigate what matter is, how matter can be classified as well as how the states of matter can be changed.

Additionally, this Inquiry unit will expand students' knowledge of how we select materials, based on their properties, how the scientific process can help us better understand the world as well as some everyday chemical reactions.
