Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA)

The Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) is provided by the Victorian Government to lower-income families to help with education-related costs.

If you have not claimed in First Semester, have a child under 16, and you hold a valid Health Care Card, Pension Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible to receive the EMA.

The allowance is paid in two instalments, one in March and one in August.

The payment is intended to assist with education-related costs such as; **uniforms**, **excursions**, **textbooks**, and **stationery**. You can elect to have your EMA paid in one of the following ways:

- Paid by direct deposit (Electronic Funds Transfer) into your own nominated bank account;
 or
- Paid to the school to be held as credit which you can use towards education expenses; or
- Paid by cheque which will be posted to the school for collection.

In 2014, the 2nd Semester EMA amount per SECONDARY student is:

- \$90 for year 7 students:
- \$75 for students in year 8 until age 16*.
- * A pro-rata amount is payable for students turning 16 in 2014.

Closing Date: You need to return a completed EMA form back to the school by 1 AUGUST 2014
