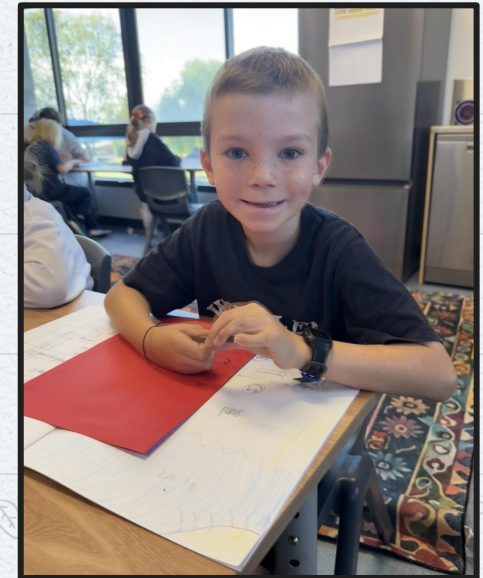
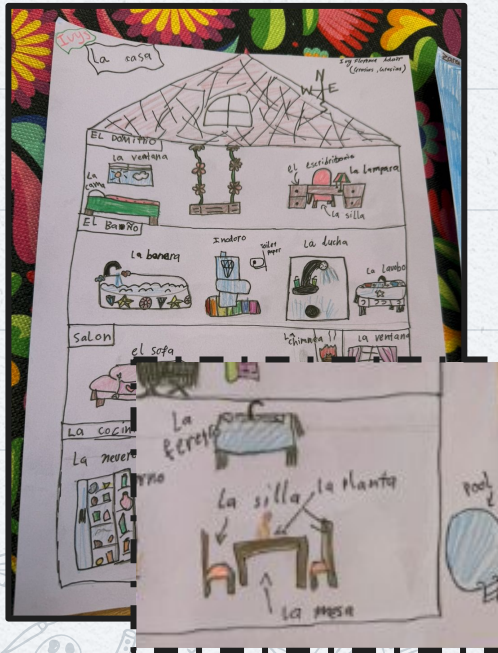

Year 3/4 students have been busy becoming little architects in Spanish and they explored vocab for different objects and spaces around the house

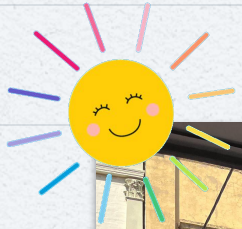
Using new vocab they designed their own “casa de ensueño” (dream home!!)



MUSIC - IN THE CLASSROOM

Year 6's have been practising their band instruments, such as piano, guitar, bass guitar & drums. Learning simple chords & basic drum beats.




Traditionally piano music is written on the treble clef staff. We will be using a combination of the staff & chord diagrams.


