Montrose Intersection Upgrade: Montrose Road closure

We're continuing works to upgrade the Montrose roundabout to a signalised intersection with additional lanes and dedicated turning lanes.

We are now progressing major construction works. We will close Montrose Road at the intersection of Mount Dandenong and Leith Roads during the school holidays from **6pm Friday 28 June to 6am Monday 15 July** so our teams can complete works in this area. During this time, we will be:

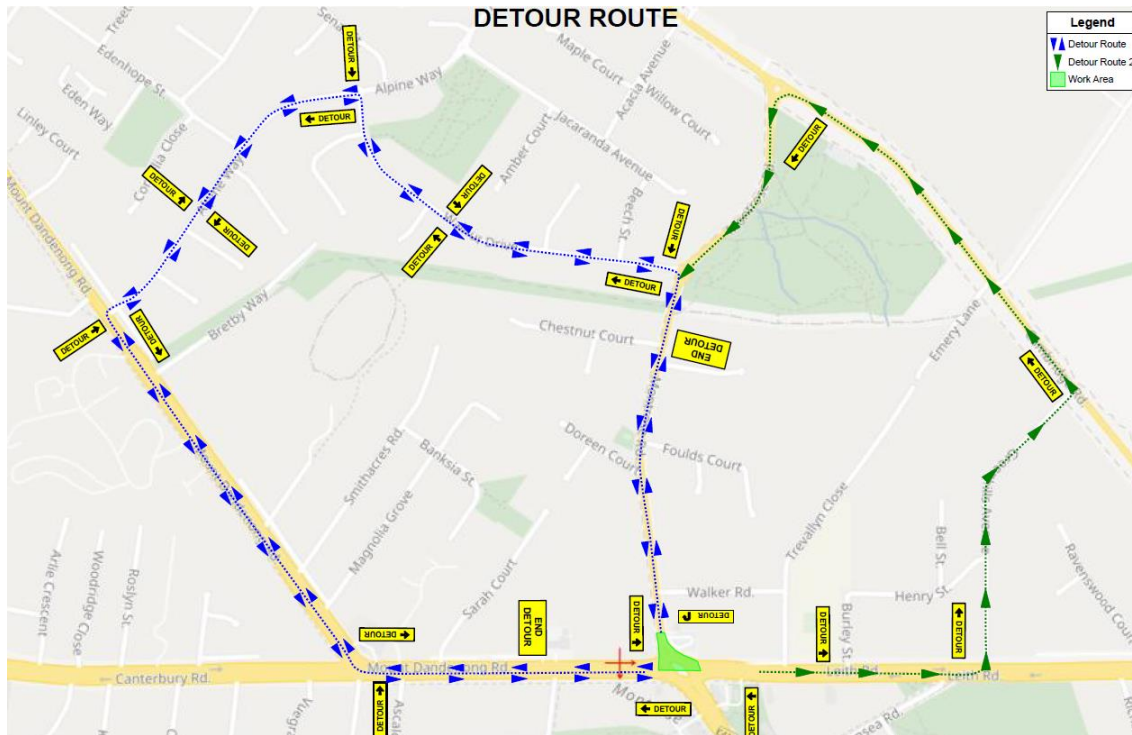
- Creating new lanes and dedicated turning lanes on Montrose Road.
- Removing old road pavement and rebuilding new road pavement.
- Installing foundations for the new traffic signals.
- Constructing a centre median and pedestrian refuges on Montrose Road.
- Installing new drainage.
- Undertaking footpath, kerb and driveway works.

During these works, a temporary closure of Trevallyn Close and Burley Streets at the intersection of Leith Road will be required to install drainage under the road. We'll keep impacted businesses and residents informed of these works and dates.

When to expect us

Our crews will work a combination of day and night shifts from **6pm Friday 28 June to 6am Monday 15 July**. Shifts during the day will be between **7am and 5pm** and shifts at night will be between **6pm and 6am**. Access to businesses will be maintained. The works are being undertaken during school holidays to minimise disruptions.

Please note that dates and times are subject to change, depending on weather conditions and contractor availability.



What to expect

Traffic management changes

- Montrose Road at Mount Dandenong and Leith roads will be closed to all traffic. A detour will be available via Mount Dandenong Road, Alpine Way and Walnut Drive or by Greenhills, Cambridge and Montrose Roads.
- A local traffic management arrangement will maintain access to properties and businesses at the intersection along with access to Walker Road. A project representative will be in contact with you before we start these works to discuss access requirements.
- The public parking area on the north-east corner of Montrose, Leith and Mount Dandenong Roads will remain open.
- Pedestrian detours may be required at certain stages of works.

To keep the community and our workers safe you may notice:

- Signage in the area to help pedestrians safely navigate the works. Detours may be required at times, but safe pedestrian access will be maintained so the community can move through the Montrose township to access public transport, shops and amenities.
- An increase in noise, light towers, dust, and vibration from construction vehicles. We'll monitor these impacts and ensure they remain within acceptable limits.
- Driveway access to be maintained for properties. There may be times when traffic controllers need to safely guide drivers in and out of properties.

Public transport

During these works, the following disruptions to bus services will be in place:

- Bus stop 9903 (Montrose Road/ Mount Dandenong Road) towards Croydon Station will be closed. Please use the temporary bus stop located between Trevallyn Close and Burley Street.
- Bus stop 9904 (Tasman Court/Montrose Road) towards Montrose will be closed. Please use stop 9905 (Montrose Brickworks Flora Reserve/ Montrose Road) instead.

Any changes to school holiday bus services will be communicated directly to affected schools.
