Student Costume Requirements

In the interests of environmental sustainability, we kindly ask families to assist us and support this event by providing basic clothing items to be <u>left at school</u> up until production day, for their child to wear during the whole school dress rehearsals. Please refer to the attached table below for the items required, and send your child's laundered items to school, clearly labelled in a named reusable bag. Details regarding hair and makeup on the day will be advised prior to production week.

- Year Three and Four students are required to please bring their t-shirts in before the end of Week Two, Term Three, Friday July 21st as these students will be creating their own costumes during Art specialist classes with the support of Mrs Jenny Riddell.
- Foundation, Year One, Two, Five and Six students are required to please bring their items to school prior to Monday, September 4th.

Students will have their items returned to them after the production has concluded. **Please note, students in Year One Two,Three and Four will have irreversible modifications made to their black T Shirt. Please do not provide irreplaceable items for this reason.** If not already on hand, the required items of clothing can be purchased from online retailers such as Target, K-Mart, Best and Less and Big W at very reasonable prices. Additional items belonging to the school will be supplied to students during rehearsals and the performances and will remain school property thereafter.
