ANDREWS CUP GYMNASTICS

The Andrews Cup Gymnastics competition will be held at **The Aquatic Centre, Somerville House, Stephens Road, South Brisbane on Thursday 4 November 2021.**

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS:

A College bus will be provided to transport our gymnasts to and from Somerville House.

Please note that the D1 and D2 team will need to be transported to Somerville House by their parent/caregiver for arrival at 7:00am. At this time, I will be waiting on the footpath for all girls to arrive. Please pull over in the drop-down zone on Stephens Rd outside of the Somerville Gymnasium/Aquatic Centre and I will assist your daughter out of the car.

All other students are to meet at the College tuckshop area at the specified time ready for transport to the competition. Students will be supervised during transport by a member of College staff. Please refer to the table below for travel arrangements.

All gymnasts must arrive at school dressed in the following uniform. They may remain in this uniform for the duration of the day. School bags may be left at school for later in the day.

WHAT TO WEAR:

Clayfield College leotard and ribbons in 'competition hair'

Clayfield College tracksuit, representative shirt, sports shoes and white socks

Underpants (for after competition)

WHAT TO TAKE:

Sports bag with named water bottle and any nutritious snacks required

SPECTATORS:

Currently, spectators will be permitted at this event; however, spectators will only be allowed entry to the venue under strict adherence to Somerville House's COVID safe plan. These requirements include:

- Individuals must not attend the event if they have COVID-19 symptoms.
- The school has the right to refuse service and must insist that anyone with these symptoms leaves the venue.
- Spectators must sign in prior to entry to the venue and sign out on departure of the venue, including hand sanitising.
- Masks must be worn on entry and exit and where social distancing is not possible.
- Spectators must remain in their school's allocated placement within the grandstand. Free movement around the facility will not be allowed, unless moving to an entry/exit point, or to access bathroom facilities.
- Spectators must seek guidance from the event organiser (Kylie Bullion) or COVID safety official (Fran McCabe) if they become unwell during the event.

Please note that this information pertaining to spectators being allowed to attend the competition, can change at any point between now and the competition, as we continue to manage the continuous and evolving effects of the current health pandemic.

A reminder there is no parking available onsite at Somerville House. Parking must be found in the surrounding streets or in the paid parking centres at Southbank and the Mater Hospital.
