# Uniform Policy

## General Uniform

Clayfield College is proud of its uniform. The uniform instils a sense of personal pride in the student cohort and is a strong representation of the College and its unity.

- The College uniform must be worn properly and totally, to and from school. This includes hat in summer and hat and blazer in winter. Jumpers or cardigans must be worn with a blazer outside the College grounds either in summer or winter (Years 7-12).
- Summer uniform will be worn all year for Years P-6. Jumpers and vests can be worn over the summer uniform as the outer garment only for Years P-6 students.
- Portions of the uniform are never to be worn with casual clothing.
- The only articles of jewellery that are permitted to be worn with the College uniform are earrings for pierced ears, and watches. Exceptions are permitted for cultural pieces of jewellery; however, these must not be visible.
- Only matching plain small studs or sleepers, gold, silver or pearl, may be worn - one in each ear lobe in the lower hole. Studs or sleepers with stones or with twisting or thickening are not acceptable.
- Tongue studs and visible body piercing is not allowed.
- Body decoration of any kind is not allowed.
- Make-up, including false eyelashes, mascara and tanning products, must not be worn. Nail polish and acrylic nails are not acceptable.
- Hair must be tidy - tied up-when touching the collar fastened back away from the face.
  - Green ribbons, clips or scrunchies are acceptable for females.
  - Males must have hair tied back with a green elastic or scrunchie.
  - Styles must be conservative, with no undercuts, mullets or inappropriate shaving, and hair colour must look natural at all times.

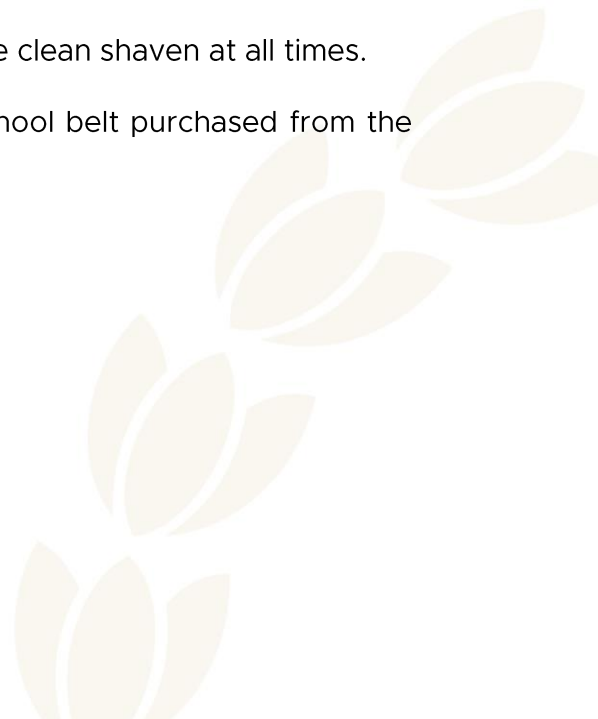
The College reserves the right to decide whether styles and/or colours are unacceptable.

- Ankle socks must be plain white in summer and turned down. Short sports socks/invisible socks are not permitted. Navy socks must be worn with long trousers, or shorts that have a belt loop.
- Full length navy stockings are to be worn with the navy skirt in winter, navy ankle socks may be worn in warmer weather during winter (Years 7 – 12).
- Navy stockings (P-12) or navy knee length socks are to be worn in winter (P-6). Navy socks must be worn with long trousers in Year 6.
- Only tights and socks purchased through the Uniform Shop will be acceptable.
- Shoes must be polished and be plain black leather with black laces - no coloured laces, stitching or metal eyelets. Suede shoes or shoes with suede trim are not permitted. Heels must be 2-2.5 centimetres.
- Years P-6 students may wear black Velcro leather shoes.
- Hats must be worn to and from school and when outdoors at morning tea and lunchtime.
- Only regulation school bags are to be brought to school and used whilst in school uniform.
- Uniform hemline should cover the kneecap, except for the skort (P – 6) and shorts which should sit on the knee.
- College (Year 7 – 12) and House badges (Prep – Year 12) must be worn as part of the uniform.
- All badges must be placed on the Secondary school uniform (image 1) and the Primary school uniform (image 2).
- Badges must be placed on the lapel of the blazer during the Winter uniform period (Year 7 – 12)
- Facial hair is not acceptable and students must be clean shaven at all times.
- For uniform with belt loops, the black leather school belt purchased from the Uniform Shop should be worn at all times.

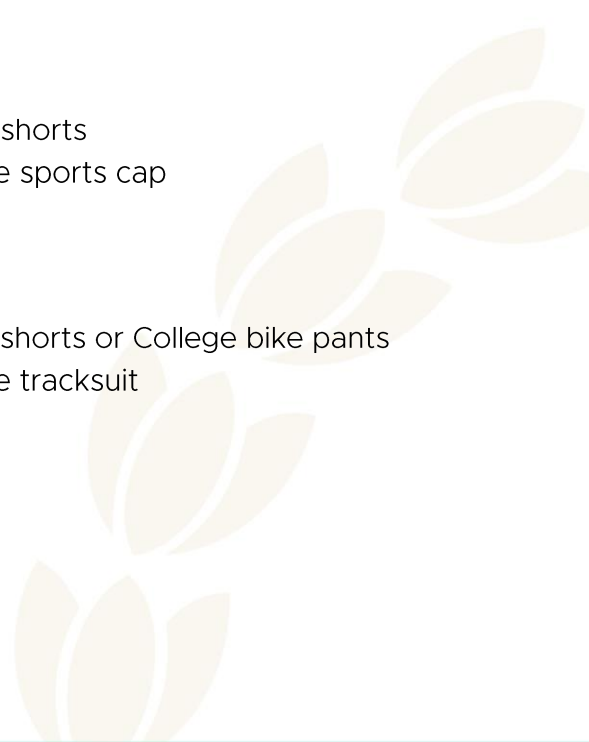

#### General Points:

- Bike pants can be worn during PE classes and training but must be covered by green shorts outside the College grounds except during training or competition.
- Students may change into sports uniform before school or at the end of breaks for PE classes in lessons 1, 2 and 4. For a lesson 3 class, students should change at the start of the lesson.
- The College tracksuit jacket, the College navy fleece or school jumper may be worn with the PE/sports uniform.
- White socks and sports shoes must be worn with the PE uniform.
- Blazers may be worn over sports uniform or track pants for travelling purposes or for official presentations at Interschool meets.
- Sports uniform may be worn outside the College if travelling by private transport for official sports practice.
- Items of College sports uniform should not be worn with club sports uniform at non-school events.
- The Spirit scarf is not to be worn to and from school or in public unless at a school sporting event.

- The formal scarf can be worn to and from school and forms part of the school uniform.
- You are NOT to appear on social media conducting yourself in an inappropriate way whilst wearing any part of the school uniform or in any way that identifies you as a Clayfield College student.

### Dress code for excursions, camps and free dress days

- Dress standards must be sun smart and conservative.
- Normal rules apply to the wearing of jewellery and make-up.
- Footwear – closed in shoes must be worn.
- Tops/Shirts – must be of a suitable length to have no midriff showing and must have sleeves. Slogans, logos, etc, must be in fitting with the image of Clayfield College.
- Shorts – must not be very short. No slashed or frayed shorts or jeans.
- Skirt/Dresses – must be of a suitable length to maximise sitting comfortably and not cause offence.
