

Cultural Awareness in Term 3


In Term 3, Cultural Awareness students are exploring Japan and a few aspects of its culture.


Haiku Poem

Students in Year 4 are learning to compose haiku poems. The haiku is a traditional Japanese short poem that consists of three lines with 5 syllables in the first line, 7 in the second and 5 in the third line. Haiku poems are simple and do not need to rhyme.
