 - 3 x 6m (and over) \$250 per site
 - an additional \$20 fee applies for those requiring power supply
- * Attendees pay an entry fee of \$5 per adult/child over 12, or \$10 for a family
- * Performance and cultural demonstration spaces are free (on approved application)
