



Program overview

The Short Term ExchangeProgram (STEP) is a 12 week cultural family to family exchange program coordinated by Rotary Districts and Clubs on both sides of the world. Students are matched based on gender and interests, attend school with their exchange sibling and live as a member of their family.

Australian students usually complete their exchange during the summer break from the end of October to end of January. Overseas exchange siblings usually stay with the Australian family first, during their summer break (July-September for Europe and Asia or Jan-March for South America).

Students must be aged 15 to 17 at the time of departure.

The program needs students and parents as a team, both committed to the exchange experience.

Countries on offer for 2026 (subject to change):

Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Czech Republic/Slovakia, Germany, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Netherlands, Poland, Taiwan, Thailand



Program Cost

The 2026 STEP Rotary Fee is \$7,000 which includes:

You will be an Ambassador


Ambassadors are typically selected by their home country's government to represent their country's interests and fostering positive relationships between their home country and the host country.
