Knox Secondary government schools work collaboratively together and are committed to not only providing the highest quality education for all secondary students within Knox but also improving and transforming secondary education in the entire Knox Local Government Area.

This semester we are proud to offer an extensive Year 12 VCE Revision Program for all students enrolled in Units 3 and 4. This program will be conducted between Monday September 20 and Friday September 24 (during the term break).

The uncertainty of the Covid-19 pandemic has meant we have changed from a single conference venue to conduct the sessions remotely online each day. The program will include online lectures by experienced presenters for many of the studies our schools offer, and access to additional online sessions for English, English Language, English Literature, EAL and Mathematics. Students attending sessions will receive excellent resources in the form of information packs through their schools prepared by each of the presenters.

The final program session times is attached. This letter is an advance notice to ensure students are aware of the attendance requirement for these sessions. This is a fantastic opportunity for our students at no cost to parents.

Participating students are required to register with individual schools by returning their school permission and medical details form to their designated staff member. These will be distributed once the full details of the program are known. The numbers are required to assist the presenters in the preparation of the resources to be distributed.

- to log in for sessions just prior to the published start time ready with appropriate resources to take notes
- not permitted to have phones during the sessions and no other potential recording devices
- to remain online for the duration of the session will be able to register questions for the presenter through the chat function
- to model mature behaviours and be respectful throughout the program.

Some sessions may not have breaks, therefore it is advisable to have a water bottle and if attending more than one session, have food on hand to eat between.
