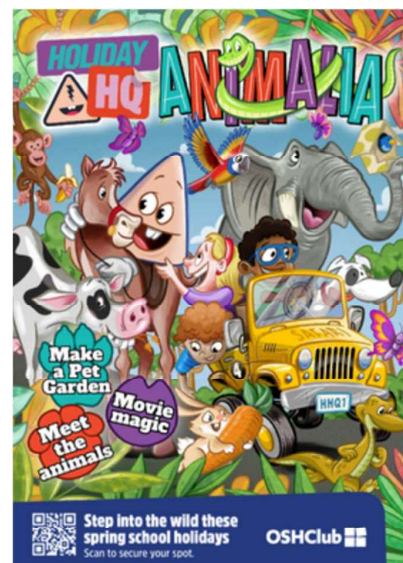

CHILD SAFE STANDARDS

Child Safe Standard 11

Here at OSHClub, we follow the Child Safe Standards which is a list of 11 standards that we need to implement to keep children safe. Child Safety Standard 11 is policies and procedures document how the organisation is safe for children and young people. We embed this standard by ensuring all staff members understand and sign the Safeguarding Children & Young People declaration form, critically reviewing and reflecting on our policies and procedures, staff completing and reflecting on the policy of the week.
