About the health/GP medical clinic

During school terms, a weekly Thursday health/GP medical clinic is provided at Scoresby Secondary School.

Working in the clinic there is a Registered Nurse, Mrs Jo Morkham, and two doctors who alternate at the clinic called Dr Prashima Illango and Dr Amitabh Ilango.

The health/GP medical clinic is a free, bulk billed service and we ensure your privacy and information is kept confidential. There may be some circumstances where we gain your consent to share your information with an appropriate person where there are safety concerns for your wellbeing.

We are here to help you with your health needs. Sometimes it can be hard to get to see a doctor after school or over the weekends. Our service is provided by the Victorian Government to make primary health care more accessible for students at school.

Doctors and Nurses are well placed to offer support and guidance on a broad range of health-related issues. We want you to have your health needs met and supported so you can be in the best health.

We open from 8.30 until 4pm, so if you need any information or support about our service, please feel free to come and have a chat with us.
