We know from verse 6 of this chapter that John the Baptist was sent by God. Thus his witness is to be believed. The words in today's Gospel from John the Baptist are for all who read or hear it. So, they are for us, today.

Who is Jesus? Some people at the time of writing of the Gospel thought he was just a Jewish teacher. The witness of John the Baptist says that Jesus is much more than that. Jesus goes beyond what people think or expect. The Gospel tells us that Jesus was sent by God and 'takes away the sin of the world'. He is the Son of God. The Holy Spirit is with him.

As we begin Ordinary Time, these statements remind us what we believe. These statements are part of the leap of faith - a leap that we are each encouraged to take, daily.

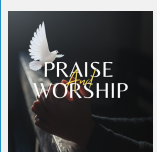
