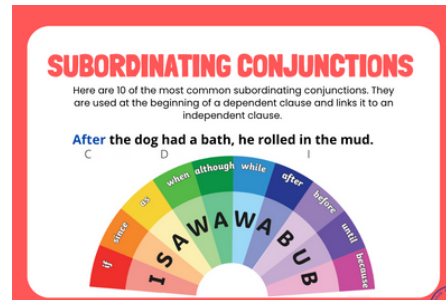
In Numeracy, students have begun learning about angles. Students are building their knowledge to create a speedy ramp!

SKILL IN FOCUS: CONJUNCTIONS

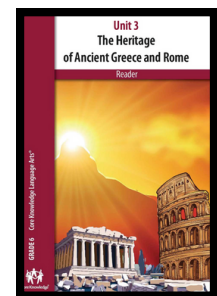
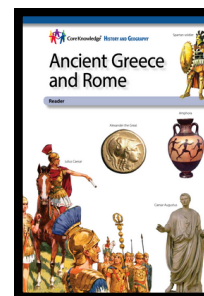


Students have been working on adding in conjunctions to create complex sentences. They are words that link two ideas together.
