### **INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR**

## MINOR BEHAVIOURS

- Lateness / Stalling / Not prepared with materials
- Interrupting / Calling out
- Touching others or others property
- Distracting or talking to others, tapping or fidgeting
- Wandering around / Avoiding work or homework
- Out of uniform
- Ignoring instruction / Passively defiant
- Swearing in conversation
- Breaking own things

### **MAJOR BEHAVIOURS**

- Multiple backchat / Aggressively defiant
- Breaking others' property
- Name calling / Racial discrimination
- Encouraging others to misbehave
- Mobile phone use
- Aggressive verbal language / Swearing
- Sexual harassment or inappropriateness
- Physical violence / Intimidation / Abuse / Bullying (any form)
- Smoking / Drugs / Weapons

- 1. Non-Verbal Prompt
- (e.g. student out of bounds, move towards student and make eye contact).
- 2. Redirect (e.g. "James you are out of bounds, please move in-bounds.")
- 3. Reteach rule
- (e.g. "Remember James, we stay in-bounds.")
- 4. Choice & Consequence (e.g. James you either return to in-bounds area or you will have to walk with me.")
- 5. If student is still non-compliant follow major behaviour steps.

Give positive feedback once desired behaviour is displayed

- 1. Student referred to identified referral location.
- Teacher completes major referral chronicle on Compass.
- 3. Parent, Guardian or Carer notified of referral.
- 4. Reteach conversation and conference at referral location.
- 5. Restorative conversation between teacher and student.
- 6. Appropriate consequence determined by teacher and Assistant Principal.
- 7. Support provided by student servies.

Apply appropriate consequence (educative)
