




What does a Mathematician do?

- Mathematicians study mathematical principles and develop their own mathematical theories and ideas.
- They may work in the theoretical realm, or they may apply their findings to financial, business, governmental, engineering, and social science issues in the larger world

What qualifies someone as a mathematician?

- A mathematician is someone who uses an extensive knowledge of mathematics in their work, typically to solve mathematical problems.
- They complete a bachelor degree in mathematics or a related field such as computer science, engineering, statistics or physics.

• Cheryl Elisabeth Praeger (born 7 September 1948 Toowoomba, Queensland) is an Australian mathematician.



Cheryl Praeger's achievements

• Praeger received BSc (1969) and MSc degrees from the university of Queensland (1974), and doctorate from the university of oxford in 1973 under direction of Peter M. Neumann.

• She has publishes widely and has advised 27 PhD students (as of march 2018).

• She is currently Emeritus Professor of mathematics at the University of Western Australia. She is best known for her works in group theory, algebraic graph theory, and combinatorial designs.
